Landfill Gas Control Works Underway.

Works are ongoing at the Kerdiffstown Landfill site to install gas control systems that will help to reduce landfill gas odours causing a public nuisance. These works relate to wells and pipes that will feed landfill gas flares. These flares will burn off gas, once operational. The EPA anticipates the gas flares will be in place and operational by the end of this month (May 2011).

Drilling of the gas wells has taken place and no problems were encountered. All 24 gas wells have been installed and sealed. The planned works described above will help reduce some of the odour. However, odour may continue to be encountered until full remediation is completed - and in particular during any work phases where wastes will be disturbed.
