Main Remediation Works

The tender documents for the main contract were issued to the shortlisted contractors on Friday 31st January 2020 with a return date for the 20th March.

It is intended to have works commencing on the Remediation and Park this Summer, with a 54 month works programme for completion of the project.

Realignment of the L2005 and development of a new site entrance and roundabout.

These works are being carried out as part of the site access improvements including the provision of a cycleway and footpath, and the installation of a new roundabout to ensure safe access to the site during the remediation phase and also for the multi-use public park.

Works are ongoing with expected completion due in May this year. Traffic management is ongoing, and we wish to acknowledge and thank road users for their cooperation and patience.

Site Management

Management of the site is continuing in accordance with the conditions of the Industrial Emissions Licence (Ref. No. P1063-01) granted by the EPA in March 2019. Day-to-day operations are controlled by a dedicated site manager and other technical staff to control 'leachate' (the run-off water that percolates through the waste) and landfill gas. Routine environmental monitoring is conducted as per licence conditions and the EPA is notified of any works or reports relevant to the licence. A team of security personnel are also retained onsite.

The Project Team will continue to keep residents, elected members and stakeholders fully informed about progress at the site and to answer any questions arising.

Kildare County Council will continue to issue community updates as remedial works on the site take place.
