This project is being undertaken by Kildare County Council on behalf of South Dublin County Council under an agreement made under Section 85 of the Local Government Act, 2001 as amended and approved by the National Roads Authority under Section 14 (8) of the Roads Act, 1993 as amended.

An Bord Pleanála, has on the 6th June 2008, made a Confirmation Order, confirming the above - named compulsory purchase order as respects the land described in Parts I, II and III of the Schedule. The said order, as so confirmed, authorises the Kildare County Council to acquire the said land compulsorily. It will become operative three weeks from the date of publication of this notice.

No. 15 of 1986) may be made to the High Court within eight weeks of the date of publication of this notice in accordance with section 50 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended.
