Business in the town centre is being severely hampered by the lack of parking, and the poor use of what little there already is. All day free parking on the weekend clogs up the car parks, many of whose owners leave the town by public transport to the city centre.

Footfall is a mere fraction of adjoining towns and is a direct result of the relatively inconvenient nature of access to Leixlip town centre.
