'Proposed Material Alterations to the Draft Leixlip Local Area Plan 2020-2026'

Date: 25th October 2019

The Draft Leixlip Local Area Plan (LAP) 2020-2026 was put to public consultation from the 30th May to the 11th July 2019. The Environmental Health Service made a submission regarding the LAP at this time. The Chief Executive submitted a report on submissions and observations received in respect of the Draft LAP to the Members of Kildare County Council for their consideration on the 21st August 2019. Having considered the Draft Leixlip LAP and the Chief Executive's Report, it was resolved by the Members at a Special Meeting of Kildare County Council to alter the Draft Leixlip LAP, and that these alterations constitute a material alteration to the Draft LAP.

The majority of the proposed material alterations to the Lexlip (LAP) seek to respond to the recent changes in National and Regional planning policy, namely the publication of the National Planning Framework (NPF) in 2018 and the Eastern and Midland Regional Assembly (EMRA) Regional Spatial and Economic Strategy (RSES) in 2019. It is considered that a material alteration is required to align the draft Lexlip LAP with the Kildare County Development Plan 2017-2023 (or any variation thereof) following the incorporation of the National Planning Framework and Regional Spatial & Economic Strategy for the Midlands & Eastern Region into same.

The Environmental Health Service has reviewed that proposed changes outlined in the plan and supports their implementation. We have no objection to the proposed material alterations and have no further comments to make at this time.
