Proposed Development: Alterations and extension to the Athy Heritage Centre, Emily Square, Athy, Co. Kildare

Dear Sir or Madam,

I refer to the above and in accordance with Article 84 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended) wish to advise that at the monthly meeting of Athy Municipal District Council held on 13th of May 2019, it was agreed by the members that the Part 8 for the above proposed development at the Athy Heritage Centre, Emily Square Athy, Co Kildare be approved subject to modifications outlined below:

- 1. The paving materials to be used throughout the scheme shall consist of indigenous natural stone and shall be consistent with the materials agreed for the Part 8 Urban Realm Improvement Scheme for Emily Square. The palette of materials to be used shall be agreed with the Planning Department, in consultation with a suitably qualified Conservation Architect, prior to commencement of development.
- 2. The sign located between the two front s shall comprise of individual lettering and logo/s affixed directly to the structure and shall not be a signage panel.
- 3. Final details regarding the requirements of the Architectural Conservation Officer of Kildare County Council, with regard to lime render on three facades of the structure (two sides and rear) shall be agreed with the Planning Department prior to commencement of development:
