



**PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT ACT 2000 (as amended)
PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS 2001 (as amended) (Part 8)**

**Royal Canal Greenway – Cloncurry to Ferrans
Lock – Reference P82017.016**

In accordance with the above regulations Kildare County Council proposes to carry out development works along the sections of the northern bank of the Royal Canal between Ferrans Lock & Cloncurry that reside within the Kildare County Boundary .

The development will consist/consists of:

- a) improvements to the existing towpath along the Royal Canal by providing a 3m wide cycleway and shared footway with a suitable surface i.e. quarry dust, surface dressing or bituminous bound surfacing depending on local conditions for pedestrian and cyclist use
- b) provision of access controls (pedestrian/cycle friendly gates) at Rathrone, Ch – 24150
- c) 2 no. 150mm duct along the full length of the greenway facility
- d) provision of new boundary treatment adjacent to domestic properties

Plans and particulars of the proposed scheme will be available for inspection or purchase at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy during normal opening hours from Tuesday 7th November 2017 until Tuesday 5th December 2017 at the following locations from 9.00am to 4.00pm:


