The goal is to **establish a common vision for the future direction of Maynooth** to ensure that it remains a desirable and resilient place to live, work, study and visit.



Why Are We Doing This?

Kildare County Council has been awarded URDF Category B funding for a Town Renewal Plan for Maynooth. The purpose of this plan is to emphasize placemaking, town centre living, improve the social and economic purpose of the town, improve movement and active travel, sustainability and climate resilience.



What is Town Centre Renewal?

Town Centre Renewal is the process of providing a framework to ensure that Maynooth remains a thriving, vibrant, climate resilient town through a common vision.

This is done by analysing the strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and challenges of the town centre in collaboration with local residents and stakeholders, and produces a common vision for the future direction of the town.

The common vision will emphasize placemaking, improvements to the public realm, opportunities for town centre living, economic development, movement and active travel, sustainability, and climate resilience.

We're in the beginning stages which is why it's important to get your input on what you feel is most important.

We're in Stage 1 of 5. More consultation work will happen in Stage 3 and Stage 5.



Enhancement & Wayfinding

We will look to improve shopfronts and streetscapes through positive placemaking and wayfinding. This could include street furniture, lighting, planting, pedestrianisation, and other schemes to make Maynooth even more attractive and easy to navigate.

Town Branding

We want to create a town brand to conceptualise, communicate and foster an image and sense of place for residents, investors and visitors.

Mobility Strategy

We will seek to address traffic and parking management with an emphasis on pedestrian and cycle connectivity between key destinations within the town centre, and traffic calming where possible and appropriate.

Town Centre Living

We want to create incentives and opportunities to encourage living in the town centre. This will improve the contribution to street life and sustainability.

Decarbonization

We want to promote environmentally sustainable projects and schemes which integrate climate change measures and adaptation opportunities while promoting Maynooth as a decarbonized zone.

District Heating Potential

We will explore the potential for district heating within the historic street grid of Maynooth.
