The content of the application form is set out in the Casual Trading Act, 1995 (Forms) Regulations, 1996.

If a licence is granted it will be necessary to share your information with statutory bodies i.e. Revenue Commissioners, Minister for Social Welfare and, where issues of non-compliance or investigation regarding alleged criminal matters, with An Garda Síochána.

If the Casual Trading Licence is granted, the information supplied by you will be kept securely for a period of up to seven years.

If you do not provide the personal data required under the Casual Trading Act 1995 and the Casual Trading Bye-Laws Kildare County Council **will not be in a position to process** your application.

Registers of Licences

A local authority is obliged to establish and maintain a register (which shall be known as the Register of Casual Trading Licences) for its functional area, of the casual trading licences granted by it under the Casual Trading Act 1995.
