1. Public Liability Insurance

❖ All applications for a Casual Trading Licence must be accompanied by evidence of public liability insurance cover indemnifying Kildare County Council in the sum of not less than €6,500,000 against any and all claims whatsoever by any person for damages for personal injuries, loss or damage caused by any act or omission of the licence holder or his/her agents.

2.. Payment Options:

- ❖ Do not, under any circumstance, send cash through the post.
- ❖ Fees shall be non-refundable in the event of a revocation of a licence.
- The licence fee will not be refunded in any circumstance.
- If application is successful applicant will be contacted to arrange payment.

3. Trading Licences for food

❖ Applicants for a trading licence relating to the sale of food (prepared or unprepared) must ensure that it is displayed/stored/kept in accordance with the Food Hygiene Regulations 1950, or any further regulations that may be made in this regard.

5. PPS No. Tax Reference No.

Applications for a casual trading licence must be accompanied by evidence of a PPS number [in the case of an individual] or a tax reference number [in the case of a company].

❖ Tax Clearance Certificate

All applications must be accompanied by a copy of a valid tax clearance certificate.

Information required to be submitted when applying to Kildare County Council for a special event licence

1. Fully completed application form.

Please ensure the following details are included:

- (a) Full Name and Address
- (b) Daytime contact telephone number
- (c) PPS Number
- (d) Description of what you propose to sell
- 2. Copy of current Public Liability Insurance Certificate/Schedule containing evidence of:
 - (a) Indemnity limit of €6.5m
 - (b) Indemnity to Kildare County Council

Evidence of renewal of your insurance must be submitted at renewal stage

- (c) Copy of current tax clearance cert
- 3. If you wish to sell food, a food licence must first be obtained from the Health Service Executive and a copy of same to be submitted with your application

4. Appropriate Fee:

The fee for an Event Licence shall be €50 in respect of the particular Event.
