

## **Terms and Conditions: Community Involvement Scheme**

- 1. Kildare County Council's Community Involvement Scheme (CIS) will be based on a local financial contributions (by landowners/residents on the road). The minimum contribution is 10 per cent and applies in all cases, applications are also subject to a maximum contribution of 20 per cent.
- 2. Kildare County Council will estimate the overall cost of the scheme taking account of material, labour, machinery, traffic management costs, etc. and will then determine the financial contribution required in each case and this will be calculated as a per cent of the total cost of the scheme. The required contribution must be paid to Kildare County Council within a specified time frame and no works will commence until this contribution has been paid in full.
- 3. The Number of CIS applications granted funding in County Kildare is dependent on funding received from the Department of Transport. Not all applications may be successful.
- 4. Kildare County Council will review all applications received for this scheme and will solely determine which applications will and will not be allocated funding under this scheme, the decision of Kildare County Council on this matter is final.
- 5. All correspondence regarding the CIS will be with the nominated spokesperson for the application and any queries etc. must be directed via the nominated spokesperson.
- 6. Once the amount of the local financial community contribution has been determined, it is the responsibility of the spokesperson for the application to collect these monies and organise payment of same to Kildare County Council by cheque, Postal Order or electronic bank transfer. The amount to be paid by individual landowners/residents is a matter to be decided between the landowners/residents themselves. Under no circumstances will Kildare County Council become involved in



the breakdown of the local financial contribution to be paid by landowners/residents or collection of same from individuals.

## 7. Eligible works include:

- Providing hard stands at field entrances
- Removal of grass verges or banks
- Site preparation works including the removal of grass from the centre of the road (where required)
- Opening, deepening and generally maintaining drains alongside roadway and adjoining land including the laying of drainage pipes, where appropriate
- Providing gully traps at suitable locations and piping to drains, where appropriate
- Opening inlets
- Opening backshores
- Unblocking of shores/surface water drains
- Repair of potholes
- Surface dressing works
- Road strengthening works
- · Repair of footpaths
- Construction of new footpaths
- 8. By the nominated spokesperson and all landowners/residents signing the application form it is understood by Kildare County Council that all signees have read, understand and agree to the terms and conditions as laid out in this document in respect to the Community Involvement Scheme. That it is known where an application fails to adhere to the scheme's terms and conditions, works shall not proceed and that funding shall either not be granted or withdrawn.
