Notes to Applicants

Please retain these notes for your own information.

1. **Public Liability Insurance**

- ❖ All applications for a Casual Trading Licence must be accompanied by evidence of **public liability insurance cover indemnifying Kildare County Council** in the sum of not less than **€6,500,000** against any and all claims whatsoever by any person for damages for personal injuries, loss or damage caused by any act or omission of the licence holder or his/her agents.

2.. **Payment Options:**

- ❖ Do not, under any circumstance, send payment through the post.
- ❖ Fees shall be non-refundable in the event of a revocation of a licence.
- ❖ The licence fee will not be refunded in any circumstance.
- ❖ If application is successful applicant will be contacted to arrange payment.

3. **Trading Licences for food**

- ❖ Applicants for a trading licence relating to the sale of food (prepared or unprepared) must ensure that it is displayed/stored/kept in accordance with the Food Hygiene Regulations 1950, or any further regulations that may be made in this regard.

5. **PPS No. Tax Reference No.**

- ❖ Applications for a casual trading licence must be accompanied by evidence of a PPS number [in the case of an individual] or a tax reference number [in the case of a company].

**Information required to be submitted when applying to Kildare County Council
to trade in the Market Square Maynooth 2013**

1. Fully completed application form.
Please ensure the following details are included:
 - (a) Full Name and Address
 - (b) Daytime contact telephone number
 - (c) PPS Number
 - (d) Provided proof of identify (copy passport/ driving licence)
 - (e) Description/Photographs of what you propose to sell
 - (f) Measurements of stall including height
 - (g) Tax Clearance Details
 - (h) Passport Photograph (This will be placed on the licence)

2. Copy of current Public Liability Insurance Certificate/Schedule containing evidence of:
 - (a) Indemnity limit of €6.5m
 - (b) Indemnity to Kildare County CouncilEvidence of renewal of your insurance must be submitted at renewal stage

3. If you wish to sell food, a letter of registration must first be obtained from the Health Service Executive and a copy of same to be submitted with your application
