## General Notes:

All services to be kept clear of crossing where possible.

All guardraits to be painted yellow, top and sides.

## Zebra Crossing

Pedestrians have right of way as they step out on to the crossing, they cause little delay to pedestrians and are generally used in the following circumstances:

Where traffic speeds are low.


Where traffic volumes are moderate

As part of traffic calming schemes

Where the carriageway width exceeds 7m provide a central refuge island.


Note:
