They discussed the steps taken during the consultation phase and explained the scope of the work involved. The strategy was approved to be brought before the Corporate Policy Group on the proposal of Cllr. Noel Heavey seconded by Cllr. Tracey O'Dwyer.

 Creative Places Athy – Arts Officer, Lucina Russell & Assistant Arts Officer, Elaine Donnelly

Lucina Russell introduced the committee to the newly appointed Assistant Arts Officer Elaine Donnelly. Ms. Russell went on to detail the work involved in Athy being confirmed as one of nine places involved in the expanded national Creative Places programme. The programme builds upon existing cultural strengths to create new momentum.
