16. Councillor Young

With the prospect of the operation of the Kildare bus routes 120, 123, 124, 126 and 130 being awarded to private operators by the National Transport Authority early in 2018, that the council resolves to write to the National Transport Authority, the Department of Transport and the Minister for Transport requesting that no bus transport operator with a record of breaching health & safety or employment laws and regulations related to road transport be accepted as a potential operator; that if a private operator is given a contract, revenues generated above the existing route operating costs be returned to the National Transport Authority and ring-fenced exclusively for funding public transport; and that if an existing public transport operator is given a contract, revenues generated above the existing route operating costs be retained and ring-fenced exclusively for funding public transport.
