
That Kildare County Council follow the example of Galway City Council in implementing bylaws similar to their Special Speed Limit Bye-Laws No.1 2020, providing for a maximum speed limit of 30kph in housing estates within County Kildare.

#### 12. Councillor Seamie Moore

In view of the concerns that have arisen in Ireland and in all of our communities around immigration and the need to show solidarity and inclusiveness with new families in our neighbourhoods, with new co-workers in our work force and with new youthful members in our schools and clubs, that a Community Integration Sub-Committee be established in each Municipal District of Kildare County Council to facilitate the development of a more harmonious Irish society.
