That the council repaint the road markings designed to reduce speeds and improve safety at Clocha Rince National School and on the approach roads to Clocha Rince National School as a matter of urgency.

That the council provide a feasibility report to the members on the possibility of installing addition public lighting on the R415, from Allenwood Cross to the entrance of Cushalla.

That the council investigates flooding/drainage issues on the corner of St Farnan's Park, Prosperous.

- An immediate reduction of the speed limit on this road which is currently 60km/h.
- The reversal of the change of priority at the junction of upper Butterstream and Loughanure roads to its original position to reduce speeding at this juncture; or using a roundabout at this junction to accommodate all traffic.



 An introduction of traffic islands or chicanes or other traffic calming measures including signage to reduce speeding.
