4. To note Section 38 of the road Traffic Act 1994 - Reallocation of road space and removal of parking bays on L1023 Ballinagappa Road, Clane (report attached).

That the council install some form of lane segregation such as planters or bollards to prevent cars parking in the cycling lane at the boys national school in Maynooth.
