That the council upgrade and extend the footpath and street lighting from the canal at Bell Harbour down to the Passlands Cemetery.

That the council undertake ditch drainage improvement works in the Townsland area of Crossmorris, Kildare to prevent on-going flooding to surrounding farmlands and residences (map previously provided to the municipal district office).
