Can the council provide an update on the taking in charge of estates in Caragh with any outstanding issues to be resolved?

8. Motion – Councillor Peggy O'Dwyer

That the council consider removing the 4 parking spaces presently at Henry Street /Charlotte Street junction to create a more seamless traffic flow.

9. **Motion – Councillor Suzanne Doyle**

That the council explore the implementation of small roundabouts/ traffic lights at pressure points in Kildare Town, such as Cross Keys, Newtown Cross and Weighbridge junction.

10. **Motion – Councillor Suzanne Doyle**

That the council devise low-cost safety measures for both Grey Abbey and Tully Road, Kildare Town.

11. Motion - Councillor Noel Connolly

That the council install traffic calming measures on the L7055 to slow traffic on the approach to Rosglass GFC and the entrance to Rosglass Avenue.
