6. Motion – Councillor Peggy O'Dwyer

That the council explores the possibility of a footpath from the Rathcurragh/Tracey's Meadows Estates, Newbridge side as presently there is no safe crossing to get to the footpath that runs on the opposite side of the road where two primary schools are located.



7. Motion – Councillor Tracey O'Dwyer

That the council carries out an assessment of need for additional traffic calming measures on the Dunlavin approach road to Brannockstown to include the junction at the Ballymore Road.

8. Motion – Councillor Noel Connolly
