8. **Motion – Councillor Carmel Kelly**
That the council commence the statutory procedure to install double yellow lines on both sides of the road at the entrance to Sallins Park as far as The Lawn.

9. **Motion – Councillor Carmel Kelly**
That the council investigate the feasibility of erecting “NO IDLING – Turn engine off” signs outside all our schools in the municipal district.

10. **Motion – Councillor Bill Clear**
That the council investigate a location to install a seat/bench on the Dublin Road on the way to St Corbans Cemetery to facilitate elderly people who want to visit their relatives buried in the cemetery.

11. **Motion – Councillor Bill Clear**
That the council install a right turn filter on the traffic lights at the junction of Sallins Road and Monread Avenue, Naas on the northbound side which activates a few seconds before the main light for southbound traffic turns green as there is only room for one lane of traffic northbound resulting in traffic mounting the footpath endangering pedestrians.

That the council investigate safety concerns at the four crossroads Killeel where the line of sight towards Rathcoole is obscured by a ditch/hedge.
