Naas Municipal District LPT Schedule of Works 2022

The members considered the Naas Municipal District LPT Schedule of Works 2022
(see appendix 1 below).

The Deputy Mayor read out the proposed allocations as outlined in Appendix 1. The
Mayor thanked the members and the Municipal District Manager for their input and
stated that these allocations were possible as a result of the variation on the baseline
LPT rate by +10% for 2022, agreed by the council last July, which would now be
coming back to the communities to be spent on projects and improvements. He

noted that approximately half the overall funding in the municipal district was allocated to roads projects which would be of great benefit to the towns and villages where works were required.

Resolved on the proposal of Councillor Moore, seconded by Councillor Kelly and agreed by all the members that the Naas Municipal District LPT Schedule of Works 2022 be approved.
