That this council writes to Uisce Éireann as the Water and Wastewater Authority for Naas Town requesting a) that a ground infrastructure survey be undertaken in the housing areas bordering Lakelands and Sunday's Well, to establish what fault lines exist that are the cause of consistent blockages over the years and b) because the main wastewater infrastructure was laid along the back gardens, the cost of clearance of blocked infrastructure from the householders of that area should be borne by Uisce Éireann until the problem is rectified.
