


Welcome to Maynooth Community Library A Social Story

The library is next to the Credit Union and the hairdressers.





The toilet is by the entrance too.




There are computers in the library which you can use.

These two are at the front of the library, in the Young Adult section. There are four more computers just past the library desk, near the Children's Section. To log on, use your library card number (written on your card), and 4digit PIN which you set with the librarian.




You can photocopy, scan and print too.

The library has the day's newspapers and some magazines that you can read, and comfortable seats to sit in.





The library is quiet most of the time, but sometimes it can be louder and busier. It's okay to make noise too!






You can borrow DVDs and video games as well as books at the library.



There are two machines for checking in and returning books. One is by the front door and one is beside the desk.

You can leave the books on the trolley next to the selfservice machine when you have returned them.








On the way to the children's area, there is a herb garden and a fish pond that you can look out at.

You can sit at the tables at the back of the building to read or study. Sometimes there will be events happening in this space. To check if it's free, you can ask one of the library staff.




The library now has a box of sensory toys and equipment that you can use while you are visiting.




We also have noisecancelling headphones and a reader pen that you can use during your visit.
